We are grateful for the community's support and excitement throughout our first full fiscal year as The Children's Museum of the Magic Valley! Imagine a community gathering place that is fun for the whole family and gives kids a place to create, explore and discover. If you can imagine it, you can achieve it! CMMV is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization in Twin Falls, Idaho incorporated in November 2018 and overseen by a dedicated board of directors. Our mission is to engage children of all ages and abilities in learning through imaginative play and discovery.

In January, we began publicly sharing our plan to create a state-of-the-art children's museum in the Magic Valley. We met with approximately 500 community members to collect feedback and forge partnerships.

Our feasibility study was conducted by the Research & Business Development Center in Rexburg, Idaho between January and April 2019. The team identified a focus group of nine children's museums in areas comparable to Twin Falls in population, median household income, number of children under 18, and distance to a metropolitan area. It investigated demographics, target audience, visitation potential and regional competition. The study formed the starting point for our business plan.

MEETING THE NEEDS OF THE MAGIC VALLEY

Community surveys revealed a tremendous desire to have a children's museum in the area. The feasibility study concluded that based on current population, our community could sustain a 15,000-20,000 square foot museum with 12,000 square foot outdoor exhibit space. There are 35,720 children ages 0-14 living within 30 miles of Twin Falls. As the 4th fastest growing micropolitan area in the nation, new community amenities should reflect the high value we place on family-friendly learning experiences.

In October, CMMV launched the STEM Family Nights Program. We reached capacity within 48 hours of opening registration to 32 elementary schools. Over 1,600 children and caregivers attended the first two events in Gooding & Declo. We will host 7 more events between January-April 2020. Each event includes the following hands-on exhibits, including over 20 built-in activities:

Making Waves

Dive into the science of sound waves as you complete five vibration investigations, make music, and capture and evaluate waveforms with our Vernier GoDirect Sound Sensors. Sponsored by Idaho STEM Action Center.

Imagination Playground
