FOUNDERS' UPDATE

We began the year with exciting news: the Children's Museum of the Magic Valley will be located on the corner of Idaho St S and 3rd Ave S! We are grateful for the opportunity to work with the Twin Falls Urban Renewal Agency to acquire the half-acre site and become part of the historic warehouse district. Thanks to our Founding 50 donors, we were ready to hire FRAME Integrative Design Strategies & CSHQA Architects to work on the concept design. Our design committee met weekly from April through August getting things "just right." In October, the Twin Falls URA Board unanimously approved our concept design. We are eager to continue with the schematic design in the coming year with FRAME Integragive Design Strageties & Laughlin Ricks Architecture.

After not being able to host events in 2020, we were eager to share our mobile outreach exhibits with the children of the Magic Valley by launching our inaugural summer of Children's Museum on the Go! The outreach program has permitted us to give the community a glimpse of what a children's museum is all about and what a phenomenal asset it will be for the Magic Valley. We are extremely grateful for grant funds which have allowed us to create such an incredible outreach program.

The museum is becoming a reality because of the community's support and our board's countless hours of volunteer time. It is a labor of love to create a place of wonder for our children and generations to come. We are honored to embark on this journey to provide a place for them to imagine, create, dream, explore and discover!

OUTREACH

We were pleased to have 2,855 people participate in 7 Family STEAM Nights and 22 Children's Museum *on the Go!* events in 2021.

This summer, we participated in 17 events in 10 weeks, serving 1,100 individuals at events within TFSD Summer Migrant School, Magic Valley Boys and Girls Club, CSI Science Camp, Jerome Summer School, E-Street Community Center & Ketchum Art Festival, to name a few.

After our successful summer events, and with TMC Lab, we are ready to create our educator-led programming, adding Food Literacy which will debut in January 2022.


We love being able to bring incredible hands-on learning and discovery to children within the Magic Valley! Seeing their faces light up with excitement makes it worth all the hard work.


STATEMENT


