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

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

The Children's Museum serves the Magic Valley through the outreach program while we raise funds to build a brick and mortar museum. This year, we held 15 Family STEAM Nights at elementary schools in Twin Falls, Jerome, Kimberly, Declo, Gooding, Burley, Wendell and Mountain Home. These hands-on events allow families to learn and play together.

It was a busy summer with 36 events in 13 weeks, serving just over 2,000 children! We partnered with Twin Falls, Jerome & Hansen School Districts, CSI Herrett Center, SPARK After-School Program, Boys & Girls Clubs of Magic Valley, E-Street Community Center, Jerome Chamber of Commerce, Idaho National Guard, and Orton Botanical Garden to assist with summer schools, camps, and community activities.

This summer, we debuted two new exhibits: Healthy You Obstacle Course and Bubbles & Splash and they both proved very popular.

Since launching in 2019, we"ve had 15,191 children and their adults play at CMMV! We've been at 127 events in 15 towns, thanks to \$148,945 in educational outreach grants!


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Why we need a children's museum
